

PROCLAMATION

Archery

Individual Tournament:

Class division:

- Classical bow: Men "Open Class" category
 - Women "Open Class" category
- Compound bow: Men "Open Class" category
 - Women "Open Class" category
- Bare-bow: Men "Open Class" category

Women "Open Class" category

Matches

- 1. A participant can participate in one category only.
- 2. The qualifying round is divided into 2 series of 12 volley of 3 arrows.
- 3. After the qualifying round, all of the participants take part in the direct elimination duel. Duels are played by direct elimination or in pools. Points will be calculated in Set and not in points (2=volleys of arrows won, 1=draw, 0=volley of arrows lost). First arrived at 6 wins the duel.
- 4. The three first participants of each category will be rewarded. Depending on the number of participants, categories could be regrouped.

Team Tournament:

Class division

- Classical bow : Mixed Open
- Compound bow: Mixed Open

Matches

- 1. One team is composed of 3 bowmen and potentially a substitute.
- 2. Teams can be made up of archers from the same company or from different companies. Every teams participate to the same ranking.
- 3. Teams are made up before the qualifying round of the individual trail. No change in the team composition will be possible.
- 4. The qualifying round is divided into 2 series of 10 flocks made up 3 arrows.
- 5. After the qualifying round, all of the participants take part of duels. Duels are played by direct elimination or in pools. Points will be calculated in Set and not in points (2=volleys of arrows won, 1=draw, 0=volley of arrows lost). First arrived at 5 wins the duel.
- 6. The three first teams of each category will be rewarded.

Rules

- 1. Two minutes are allowed by volley of 3 arrows.
- 2. Every kind of arrows are allowed (wood, carbon...)
- 3. Bow power: 60 pounds maximum



PROCLAMATION

- 4. Arrows are shot outside at a 30 meters distance from a target archery of 80 diameter (classical bows and bare-bows) and tri-spots of 60 (compound bows).
- 5. Arrows:
 - Spine length 9,3mm maximum
 - Spine diameter 9,4mm maximum.
- 6. Unless otherwise specified, the rules of the World Archery Federation apply.
