Bowls - Petangue

Game model

- 1. Petanque is a sport in which:
- a) 2 players play against 2 players Doubles. Each player uses three boules.
- b) 3 players play against 3 players Triples. Each player uses two boules.
- 2. The game is played on any ground with dimensions 4 m x 15 m. Variation down to 3 m x 12 m is allowable.

Matches

- 1. The tournament will be held under the ABC Pool/CUP system to even out differences in strength between the participating teams. (see general information Sports disciplines point 5 Tournament planning page 25).
- 2. a) The double/triple which has won the most games is the winner.
 - b) The double/triple is ranked in each pool on points, so that the double/triple with most points is no. 1 and the next best team is no. 2 etc.
 - If 2 doubles/triples are tied, the games they have played together decide the result.
 - If the teams are still tied, the team with the biggest difference between games won and games lost and then the biggest score, is the winner.

Playing time

• The game is generally played up to 13 points, but pool games may be played to 11 points (50 minutes maximum per game in pools).

Rules

- 1. Unless otherwise specified, the rules of the International Petangue Federation apply.
- 2. Even a referee must apply the international rules.
- 3. Detailed game rules are published in the tournament program.
