# Squash

### Class division

- Men "Open Class" for all ages
- Men "Senior Class" for 40 years and over (40+)
- Women "Open Class" for all ages
- Mixed "Open Class" for all ages
- Mixed "Senior Class" for 40 years and over (40+)

Team tournament for women's, men's and mixed teams (1 woman, 2 men/under and over 40 years). A team consists of 3 (no more than 6) players. Each match will consist of the following games: 3 singles.

#### Game model

- 1. Games can be played without a referee. The players themselves judge the individual games.
- 2. Rackets and balls must be approved and meet WSF specifications.

### **Matches**

- 1. The tournament will be held under the round robin system. The participating teams will be divided into groups made up of 3 to 5 teams in the preliminary round.
- 2. a) The teams who has won the most games in a match is the winner.
  - b) The teams are ranked in each pool on points, so that the team with most points is no.1 and the next-best player is no.2 etc.

## Scoring system

- 1. Point-a-rally scoring (PARS) to 11 will be used.
- 2. Each match consists of the best of 2 games of 11 points (PARS).

## **Rules**

- 1. Unless otherwise specified, the rules of the World Squash Federation (WSF) apply.
- 2. Even a referee must apply the international rules.
- 3. Detailed game rules are published in the tournament program
