# **Bowls - Petanque**

#### Class division

No division

#### Game model

- 1. Petangue is a sport in which:
- a) 2 players play against 2 players Doubles. Each player uses three (3) boules.
- b) 3 players play against 3 players Triples. Each player uses two (2) boules.
- 2. The game is played on any ground with dimensions 4 m x 15 m. Variation down to 3 m x 12 m is allowable.

## **Matches**

- 1. The tournament will be held under the ABC Pool/CUP system to even out differences in strength between the participating teams.
- 2. a) The double/triple which has won the most games is the winner.
  - b) The double/triple is ranked in each pool on points, so that the double/triple with most points is no. 1 and the next best team is no. 2 etc.
    - If 2 doubles/triples are tied, the games they have played together decide the result.
    - If the teams are still tied, the team with the biggest difference between games won and games lost and then the biggest score, is the winner.

# Playing time

- Duration of preliminaries and knockout games: 50 minutes plus one additional jack.
- The final games are played to 13 points.

#### Rules

- 1. Unless otherwise specified, the rules of the International Petangue Federation apply.
- 2. The players should have with them the official from F.I.P.J.P. boules.
- 3. In the event of extreme condition weather, the competition will be cancelled!
- 4. When taking shots at the end line, please take the necessary precautions, and, if necessary, mark the boules and the jack.
- 5. When reporting to the officials on site, each team taking part in the double's competition will receive 2 team numbers and a scorecard; each team taking part in the triple's competition will receive 3 team numbers and a scorecard. Please ensure that the team number is clearly visible.
- 6. After the game, the result must be entered in the scorecard and signed by the opponent. The captain of the winning team is requested to report the result to the tournament director immediately.
  - a. Please note: A new round may only begin after all results have been reported!
- 7. Even a referee must apply the international rules.
- 8. Detailed game rules are published in the tournament program.
- 9. Duration of preliminaries and knockout games: 50 minutes plus one end.
- 10. The final games are played to 13 points.
