Class division

- Men "Open Class" for all ages
- Men "Senior Class" for 40 years and over (40+)
- Women "Open Class" for all ages
- Women "Senior Class" for 40 years and over (40+)
- Mix "Open Class" for all ages
- Mix "Senior Class" for 40 years and over (40+)

Game model

Team tournament for men's and mixed teams (under and over 40 years). Each team consists of no more than 12 players. Mixed teams must have at least 3 female players on court. The participating teams will be divided into groups made up of 3 to 5 teams in the preliminary round.

Matches

1. The tournament will be held under the ABC Pool/CUP system to even out differences in strength between the participating teams.

- 2. The teams are ranked in each pool on points, so that the team with most points is no.1 and the next-best team is no.2 etc.
 - If two teams are tied, the games they have played together decide the result.
 - If the teams are still tied, the deciding factor is first the better set ratio, then the better point ratio.

Playing time

1. Games are played to the best of 3 sets. Break between sets - max. 5 minutes.

2. Each set is played up to 25 points and 15 points in the event of a third set. At 24-all the 2 point lead rule will for time reasons NOT be applied.

Net heights

The Following net heights will apply: Men 2.43 m Women 2.24m Mix 2.35 m

Rules

The teams are requested to report to the tournament director 30 minutes before their first match is set to begin. The list of the team members must be filled in 30 minutes before start of the match. Mikasa MVA 200 balls with the ÖVV seal of quality will be used. All players are asked to wear shoes with non-marking soles.

1. Unless otherwise specified, the rules of the International Volleyball Federation apply.

- 2. Even a referee must apply the international rules.
- 3. Detailed game rules are published in the tournament program.
