Tournament System: 9 round Swiss system (rapid) with FIDE rating. All FIDE and Greek Chess Federation regulations apply.

Time Table:

Thursday, October 7th	1-3rd round	at 10:00 am
Friday, October 8th	4th-6th round	at 10:00 am
Saturday, October 9th	7th-9th round	at 09:00 am
Saturday, October 9th	Closing Ceremony	at 13:00

Time Control: 20 minutes plus 30 seconds per move from move 1, for each player. Player who does not appear 10 minutes after the start of the round will lose the game.

Tie-Breaks: To resolve possible tie-breaks the following criteria will be applied:

- a) Buchholz cut 1
- b) Sonneborn-Berger
- c) Direct encounter

Postponements: Postponement of a game is generally not allowed.



Appeals: Appeals may be submitted up to 10 (ten) minutes after the end of the round. A 3-member Appeals Committee (AC) will be responsible for their examination. Members of the AC related to the players involved will be exempted. The Chief Arbiter will appoint the composition of the AC before the start of the tournament. The appeal fee is set at 100€ and may be deposited to the Tournament Director or the Chief Arbiter. Should the appeal be vindicated, the fee shall be returned to the appellant otherwise it is withheld by the organizers.

Prizes:

1st winner Gold Medal

2nd winner Silver Medal

3rd winner Bronze Medal

1st Female Gold Medal

2nd Female Silver Medal

3rd Female Bronze Medal

If player is entitled to more than one prize shall receive the one that is first in the row of the prize table.
